MALA POLICY
RETIRED MEMBER STATUS

Any full Member in good standing, who has permanently retired from the active practice of the profession after not less than 20 years of landscape architectural practice, or, after not less than 15 years of continuous membership in the Association, shall be eligible, upon application, to be granted the **Retired Member** status. A 2/3 majority vote of Council shall be required for approval.

A **Retired Member** shall retain all privileges of a Member of the Association, including CSLA membership, but shall be allowed a 50% reduction in the annual (combined MALA and CSLA) membership dues.

MALA POLICY
LIFE MEMBER STATUS

Any full Member or Retired Member in good standing for at least 20 years, who has retired from active practice and has made a significant contribution to the profession, may be nominated by the Association for **Life Member** status. The following process shall apply:

- a) The Association shall prepare a written report, outlining the candidate's background and contribution to the profession and community.
- b) Following approval by a 2/3 majority vote of Council, the nomination shall be forwarded to the President Elect of the CSLA.
- c) The application and supporting documents shall be reviewed by the Board of Governors at its annual spring meeting. A 2/3 majority vote shall be required for approval.

A **Life Member**, duly recognized by both organizations, shall retain all privileges of a Member, but shall be exempt from the requirement to pay any annual membership dues.
