**MALA POLICY**  
**ACTIVE INTERNATIONAL MEMBERS**

In order to promote and accommodate reciprocity among member organizations of IFLA (International Federation of Landscape Architects) the Manitoba Association of Landscape Architects has developed a special category for *Active International Members*.

An *Active International Member* is an individual who has his/her place of residence and office outside of Canada, is an accredited Member of an association or institute similarly constituted to MALA and remits dues through that organization, but also intends to carry out landscape architectural work in Manitoba.

International applicants will be evaluated by MALA on individual merit. Evaluation of equivalency of professional degree in Landscape Architecture and membership in a similarly constituted association or institute will proceed under the direction of the Canadian Society of Landscape Architects, in compliance with the guidelines of Canadian Government Services:

International Qualification Assessment Services  
International Credentials Evaluation and Language Proficiency  
World Education Services

To meet the MALA requirement for satisfactory proof of membership in an IFLA organization, applicants for this category of membership will arrange for the association or institute to submit a letter confirming full membership in good standing in lieu of obtaining signatures of endorsement on the application.

*Active International Members* are assessed international dues and are entitled to all membership privileges, as described in the By-laws.
