

# Tenure-Track Position In Landscape Architecture

The Department of Landscape Architecture at the University of Manitoba invites applications for a full-time tenure-track position at the rank of Assistant Professor to commence July 1, 2008 or soon thereafter.

We seek candidates with a passion for design and the ability to transmit it to students. Equally, the candidate will have a passion and proficiency with digital media in the teaching and practice of Landscape Architecture and Urbanism. Teaching responsibilities will include design studio, seminar and lecture format courses at the undergraduate and graduate level in the Department and Faculty of Architecture. Other responsibilities include creative/scholarly work, advising graduate students, and the performance of service and/or outreach duties. Candidates with experience in practice are encouraged to apply.

The Department of Landscape Architecture is currently undergoing a restructuring process with regard to our input in the undergraduate Environmental Design program, and our existing Masters program. The new undergraduate stream 'Landscape + Urbanism' offers exciting potential to educate students with an explicit understanding of the systems involved in the design of urban environments. Equally exciting new opportunities exist in the Masters program and we anticipate that the candidate will also be engaged in this process.

The Faculty of Architecture is dedicated to studies in the design of human settlements. It comprises four graduate departments offering first professional degrees in Architecture, City Planning, Interior Design or Landscape Architecture, a three-year inter-disciplinary undergraduate program in Environmental Design and a newly established Ph.D. in Design and in Planning. The Faculty hosts a number of inter-departmental international studios and encourages a high level of inter-disciplinary collaboration. The program in Landscape Architecture is fully accredited by the CSLA with equivalency with the LAAB. Candidates must possess a Master's degree in Landscape Architecture or in a related discipline from an accredited institution. A PhD in a related design discipline is desirable. They must also be eligible for membership in a component organization of the Canadian Society of Landscape Architects (CSLA). The University of Manitoba encourages applications from qualified women and men, including members of visible minorities, Aboriginal peoples, and persons with disabilities. All qualified candidates are encouraged to apply, however, Canadians and permanent residents will be given priority.

Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience. The appointment will be in accordance with the terms and conditions of the current Collective Agreement between the University of Manitoba and the University of Manitoba Faculty Association.

Applicants should submit a Curriculum Vitae and a portfolio of their professional work, research and creative activities together with the names of three (3) referees by April 7, 2008. The position will remain open until filled.
