Candidates must have professional experience in landscape architecture and/or landscape planning, and the ability to teach design studios and practice-oriented lecture courses, and to advise thesis / practicum students.

The position includes teaching studios and lecture courses in the ED 3 and ED 4 years of the Landscape + Urbanism option and/or the Master of Landscape Architecture (MLA) program. Teaching load will be subject to the forthcoming Faculty of Architecture Guidelines and will generally comprise two studios and one lecture course or one studio and two lecture courses in each academic year.

- eligibility for full professional membership of the Manitoba Association of Landscape Architects / Canadian Society of Landscape Architects
- demonstrable research ability and achievement
- competence in studio teaching and in practical skills instruction
- competence in current digital technologies (with GIS abilities being an asset).
